Elective Courses



NOTE: Course credits and contact hours for Special Topic classes may vary. Additional tuition applies per credit hour. There is no refund for dropping or withdrawing from an elective course. In order for the class to make, 10 students must be signed up for each course.

CHELEC.CC Advanced Emergency Cardiac Care 1 credit, 15 hours

Presentation of recent advances in patient assessment and treatment in pre-hospital emergency care, including pain, arrhythmias, congestive heart failure, and shock as complications of acute myocardial infraction.

CPELEC.OB Advanced Obstetrics and Gynecology 4 credits, 60 hours

Introduction to advanced obstetric and gynecological practices designed to familiarize the chiropractor with the diagnostic techniques and their application in various emergencies. Pelvic examination and its interpretation are included. A hospital visitation is included in this course.

CPELEC.LB Laboratory Technique 1 credit, 30 hours

The purpose of this course is to instruct the student in safe and efficient methods of collecting blood and urine samples for laboratory analysis.

CPELEC.MS Minor Surgery 1-7 credits, TBD hours

The diagnosis and treatment of minor surgical problems. Subjects covered are: patient selection, antisepsis, dermatological problems, suturing technique, sterile technique and elective surgery.

PREREQUISITE: Standing as a trimester 6 or higher.

CHELEC.RE Research II 1-7 credits, TBD hours

Independent study designed for those students with strong basic science backgrounds, accomplished under the direction of the Research Department. The student will assist in basic laboratory research according to the area and degree of competence.

ANELEC Special Topics in Anatomy 1-7 credits, TBD hours

Special topics in anatomy designed to enhance the student's knowledge in particular areas of interest.

MBELEC Special Topics in Microbiology 1-7 credits, TBD hours

This course includes special topics in microbiology geared to the student's area of interest.

PAELEC Special Topics in Pathology 1-7 credits, TBD hours

Special topics in pathology and their relationship to chiropractic practice.

PHELEC Special Topics in Physiology 1-7 credits, TBD hours

This course includes special topics in physiology or biochemistry.

CHELEC.TQ Special Topics-Technique 1-7 credits, TBD hours

An introductory course in various methods of technique. The fundamental concepts are demonstrated and practiced. Technique topics may vary.
