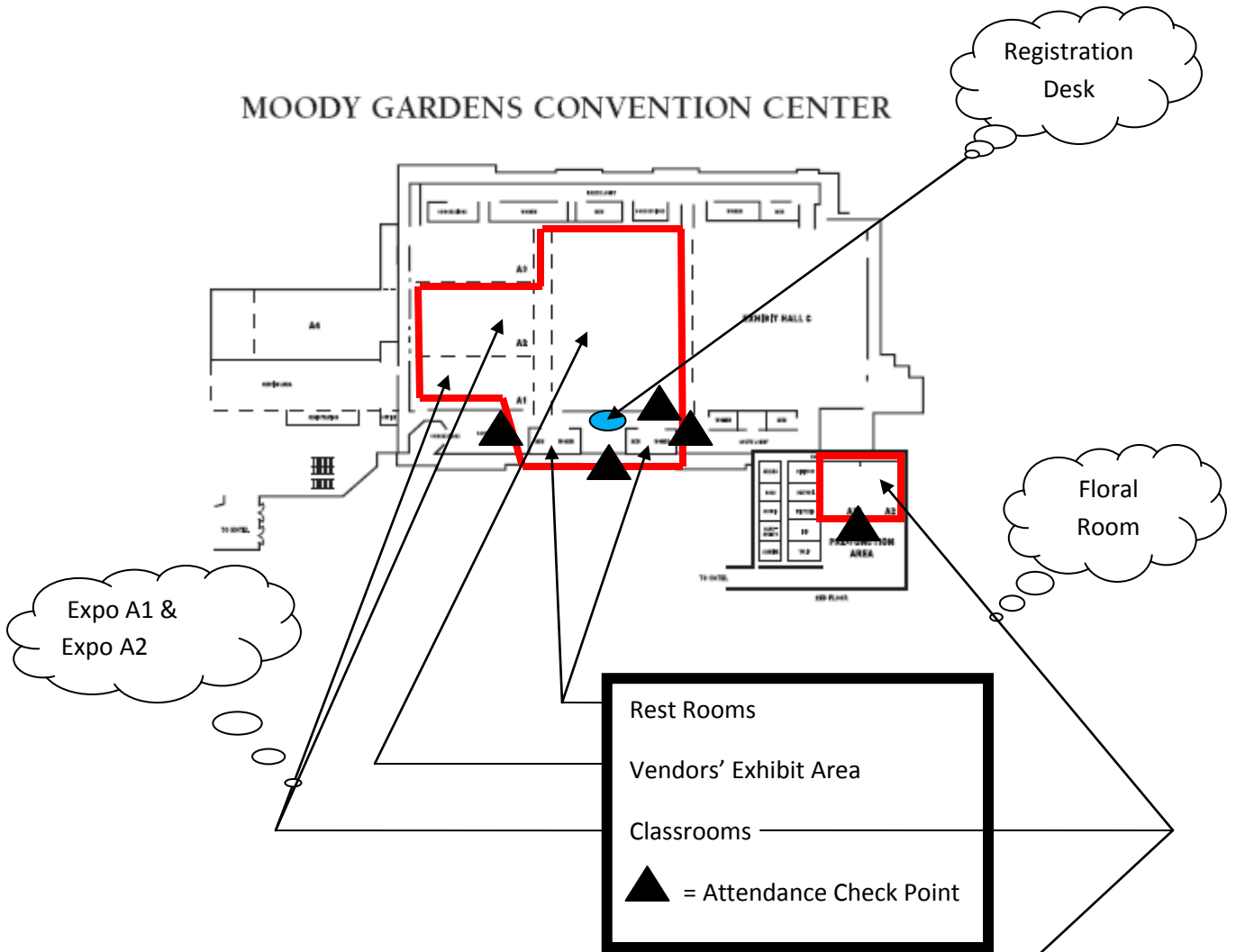
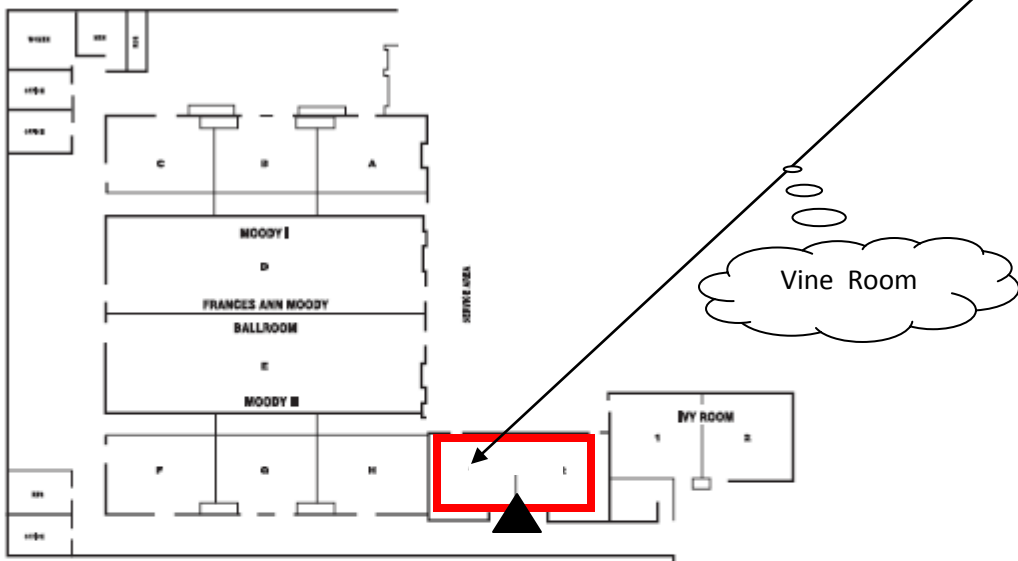

MOODY GARDENS HOTEL MEETING ROOMS



The areas outlined in red (both the Convention Center and Hotel) represent expo areas (classrooms), vendors' exhibit area, registration desk, restrooms, and attendance check points. Participants will only be scanned when entering or exiting the check points. Hours for continuing education can be earned while remaining in the red areas. Time will not be deducted for restroom breaks on the Convention Center floor in front of the registration desk. The only three exceptions where attendance will be monitored at the classroom door are the main classroom for the mandatory board hours (Expo A2), the Floral Room upstairs in the Convention Center, and the Vine Room in the Hotel.

Note: Participants on the main floor of the Conference Center can freely move between Expo A1, Expo A2, and the Vendor's Exhibit Area while earning hours for continuing education, including the restrooms in front of the registration desk, without having to be re-scanned. Participants desiring to leave the main floor conference area must check out at one of the four check points. Time for continuing education will continue once the participant checks in at the Floral Room, Vine Room or returns to the main floor of the Conference Center.

Example: Dr. Smith registers at the front desk and scans in at the Vendor's Exhibit Area at 8:00 a.m. He attends the class in Expo A1 from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. He leaves the classroom at 9:00 a.m. and visits the various vendors in the exhibit area till 10:00 a.m. He decides to attend the class in the hotel's Vine Room. He scans out of the Vendor's Exhibit Area at 10:05 a.m. He walks through the connecting corridor between the Conference Center and the Hotel to the Vine Room. He is scanned at the front door of the Vine Room at 10:10 a.m. and remains in the class until 11:00 a.m. He is scanned out and returns to his hotel room. He will be credited two hours and 50 minutes.

Participants can earn an average total of eight hours of continuing education credit per day for the three-day conference, minus the time away from the main Conference Center floor, The Floral Room, and Vine Room. The Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners requires 16 hours of continuing education annually. Of the 16 hours, four mandatory hours required by the board in ethics, risk management, and documentation will be offered both on Friday and Saturday for participants to plan accordingly. Minimizing time outside of the red areas and appropriately utilizing lunches and breaks will afford participants ample opportunity to earn 16-hours of continuing education credit during any two of the three convention dates.
